SENATOR SCHROCK: I waive closing.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: He waives closing. The question is the advancement of LB 449 to Select File. All in favor vote by voting aye; all opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 449.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The bill advances. Next bill.

CLERK: LB 449A by Senator Schrock. (Read title.) I do have an amendment to the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Schrock, to open on the bill.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Madam President, members of the Legislature, this is simply the A bill that follows LB 449. It is a cash-funded program and the expenditure...and the cash funds pretty well match the expenditures that DEQ will expend. The first year of the program is probably around \$87,000; second year could be about twice that much at \$175,000.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Mr. Clerk, did you say there's an amendment?

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Schrock would move to amend, AM2199. (Legislative Journal page 267.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Schrock, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Madam President, members of the Legislature, the amendment to LB 449A makes technical revisions to update fiscal year designations and creates a personnel service limit so that Department of Environmental Quality may hire staff to implement the provisions of LB 449.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Is there discussion on the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Schrock, to close on the amendment. Senator Schrock waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM2199 to LB 449A. All in favor vote aye; all opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record,
