The reason Senator Foley, the reason Julie Schmit-Albin, and their ilk don't want this information is because they want young women to carry pregnancies to term, whether the young women want to or not, whether it's in the best interest of the young women or not. I'd like to ask Senator Foley one question.

SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Foley.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Foley, before I proceed...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Excuse me.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and overstate something, the question I ask you is this. If a young woman is impregnated by her biological father, do you believe she should be able to get an abortion?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Foley.

SENATOR FOLEY: I think she should be given all the assistance she needs to carry the child to term.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you believe she should be allowed to have an abortion?

SENATOR FOLEY: The law provides that she can.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm asking for your belief. If you don't want to give it, I'm not going to badger you or hound you on it. Are there some exceptions you make as in the matter we're discussing here or do you believe that a woman never should be allowed to have an abortion? And maybe that's the way I should phrase the question.

SENATOR FOLEY: Well, never, never is a difficult...
