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SENATOR CHAMBERS: I agree.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay. Thank you, Senator Chambers. Members, I believe...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...that this is a good, a very good amendment to my amendment, and I would just encourage that you adopt it on the off chance that you're going to adopt my amendment, as well. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Chambers, and this will be your third time, as you know.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Schimek asked me a few questions about this amendment. I'm very serious about it. And as she pointed out, on the chance that her amendment may be adopted, this one should be a part of it. I do not like the idea of a young woman having to lay her business before these school employees. When this bill was in its early stages of consideration, there was an article in the Omaha World-Herald. Several counselors and other school employees were asked about the bill, the current state of the law, and the practice at these people's respective schools. I don't remember whether the person was a nurse, a counselor, or a teacher. But this person said, as soon as a young person comes to her, she tells the young person I'm going to tell your parents. Well, that defeats the purpose of the judicial waiver. This person explained that she is trying to put pressure on the young woman to tell her parents. If the employee does not intend to rat out the young girl, the employee has lied, attempted to coerce the young woman's will, and has acted in a way that I think a trusted one ought not act toward one who is reposing trust in that person. If, in fact, that school employee does tell the parent, the parents, guardian or guardians, that school employee is acting in a way that's contrary to the spirit of the law. I don't know whether any rules of confidentiality are violated, but certainly the trust that the young woman had reposed in this individual is violated by the individual ratting her out.
