SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. The house is under call. Amendment FA1438 to AM2361, have you all voted? Senator Chambers, for what purpose do you rise?
