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or the other, or both. And, to me, it's just criminal if we don't let these young women know what the law says in regard to parental notification and judicial bypass, and this amendment, my amendment, that's up there is the, again, we've been on it for a long time, the designated teacher or counselor amendment in which somebody in that school is designated as a holder of that information. And probably in some cases it would be several in that school building that would be able to provide that information. So I would just ask you to carefully consider, is that an onerous burden? Is that something that we can't approve? It's not my first choice, believe me, but it is absolutely better than nothing, so I would ask you to think about it. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: One minute. Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, were Senator Schimek not on the wrong side of my amendment she might have given me that one minute to speak, but it shows that she and I don't see eye to eye on everything, but I'm glad it's on something like a preposition rather than a matter of great substance. I just have a few more words that I need to say to unburden my soul. I made the mistake when I was growing up, when I was knee-high to a hopper grass, of reading the Bible for myself. I didn't believe that any book could have the craziness in it that people attributed to the Bible. Now, the crazinesses that they attributed to the Bible, I found out, indeed were being interpolated by them, not interpreted. But then I found crazinesses of a higher magnitude than those. But there was a story about a guy named Job and I'm not going to tell that whole story, but one of the people who came to consult with Job when he was having some troubles said that he just had to speak or he would burst. He had to or he would burst. I must speak or I will burst. And as I stated the last time, I don't care whether they get a cloture vote or not. If they do, then I'm just going to start on the very next bill. Senator Foley thinks I won't do it. I saw him...a comment by him ridiculing me saying these threats are made on a daily basis. Well, when I do it, thank Senator Foley. What a lot of people who don't read the newspaper don't realize, Senator Aguilar, is that as thinly
