PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The report is adopted. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next report is offered by the Natural Resources Committee. That report is found on Journal page 453.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The Chair would recognize Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, on January 28, the Natural Resources Committee held a hearing on the confirmation of Eugene Bade to the Power Review Board. The committee voted unanimously in favor of Mr. Bade's appointment. Mr. Bade...the Power Review Board is required to have an accountant on their board, and Mr. Bade fills that requirement. He is a graduate of Creighton University, with a degree in accounting. He is currently employed by the accountant...as an accountant with Countryman Associates, previously employed with the KN Energy as their director of internal audit, and as vice president of marketing subsidiary and corporate controller. He does volunteer work as a Cub Scout pack leader, a Little League baseball coach, and client education work at a therapeutic care facility for recovering female addicts. PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Schrock. The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I would like to ask Senator Schrock a question.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Schrock, did the committee explore what this gentleman's attitude is toward public power, as opposed to privatization?
