SENATOR SCHROCK: I do not know that they've been involved in that. My suspicion is they have not been involved. That's policy decision, and I don't think they'd be involved with that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's all I will ask. Thank you, Senator Schrock.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Further discussion? Seeing none, the Chair recognizes Senator Schrock to close. He waives closing. The question is on the adoption of the Natural Resources Committee confirmation report. All those in favor please vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal pages 494-495.) 30 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the report, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The report is adopted. Next item, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next report is offered by the Revenue Committee, and is found in the Journal on page 453.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The Chair would recognize Senator Connealy.

SENATOR CONNEALY: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members. The Revenue Committee would suggest your confirmation of...reconfirmation of Robert L. Hans as a commissioner to the Tax Equalization and Review Commission. Mr. Hans was at the hearing, and was supported by 6 affirmative votes and no opposition. This Lincoln native is, once again, a reconfirmation.
