everybody else's car. And so I rise to...for a couple of different reasons, but just probably the main one is, is to point out that this is a criminal statute. It will make an additional criminal class, that being adults, parents, other people, drivers, even young people that would violate this subject to a criminal conviction, fines, and points off of their driver's license. And as such, I think a criminal statute needs a little extra scrutiny to make sure that it passes that muster and, as I opined before, I don't think that LB 227 hits the mark. If we truly are interested in the safety of all young people, then a speed limit limitation on it makes much more sense than anything based on employment or agricultural activity or location, just an across-the-board speed limit that would apply across the state in a reasonable fashion. And so, while I don't know that the speed limit of 20 that Senator Chambers has proposed is a reasonable one, the reason why I came up with 25 miles an hour, as I stated before, is because that is what the speed limit is in our residential areas. In our most heavily populated areas, we think or we have set as a public policy in the...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.
