All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is adoption of the Chambers amendment, FA1442. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 7 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment to the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment was not adopted. I do raise the call. Mr. Clerk, next item to the bill...or to the amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend the Quandahl amendment with FA1443. (Legislative Journal page 501.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on FA1443 to AM2236.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm going to up the ante, and maybe I can get Senator Aguilar's agreement with this amendment. Instead of having the truck limited to a rate of 25 miles per hour or less, I would say 30 miles per hour or less. And I'm going to keep ratcheting it up to see just how many miles per hour various lunkheads feel these vehicles ought to be able to drive and endanger these children before the exception will not apply. I'm going to look at this bill again. I don't think Senator Beutler's amendment does much to touch at all the concerns that I have. The number-one concern is the welfare of young people. As I say, the vote on LB 172 to keep young women ignorant shows that there is not a great amount of interest on this floor in the welfare of young people.
