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SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, we will be...

SENATOR CUDABACK: ...Senator Schrock come forward?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...happy to come to the front.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you please do that. Senator Chambers had requested a division of the question. I rule that it is divisible. Mr. Clerk, please read the division.

CLERK: Well, Mr. President, pursuant to a discussion with Senator Chambers and Senator Schrock, three components of the committee amendments. The first will be lines 1 through 11 of the original committee amendment, lines 1 through 11 of the original committee amendment. Second component will be lines 12 through 16. Second component is lines 12 through 16. And third component will be line 17 through the balance of the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, being as you have opened, we'll take up number one. Did you have any additional things you wish to state on 1 through 11 of the original committee amendments? (FA1445, Legislative Journal page 505.)

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator...or Mr. President, members of the body, this is the amendment--Senator Chambers has divided it three ways--this is the amendment that I had asked to be defeated so we can get to the amendment that's been filed. And so I would ask...Senator Chambers has asked to divide it. So I would ask that we would...if that's the case, I would ask that we vote against all three of these amendments. That would be my preference. And this was the original amendment to the bill that we have agreed to bypass in favor of the new amendment. So with that, I would ask you to defeat...the Chair, if I might ask, this has been divided, right?

SENATOR CUDABACK: It has been divided in three different...

SENATOR SCHROCK: Then I would ask that the body vote down the advancement of all three of these divisions.
