SENATOR SCHROCK: I'm sure I've heard it, Senator Bourne, but I don't recall...

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay.

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...what it is.

SENATOR BOURNE: I'm curious about how much that is. And before I would vote for the amendment, I'll want to know those numbers. That's...

SENATOR SCHROCK: Can I have a little of your time here?

SENATOR BOURNE: Sure.

SENATOR SCHROCK: I would just say that before your city council and mayor would raise taxes, they would have hearings, there would be public input,...

SENATOR BOURNE: I apprec...

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...and the same would be true with NRDs.

SENATOR BOURNE: You bet. I appreciate that. And I know that the cities are in a bind, that they're in a fix trying to meet this mandate. And yet, I think that it's incumbent upon us to know exactly how much money this is. Can you answer...it also allows NRDs to assess an additional 1 cent per \$100, in addition to the 4.5 cent authority they already have. Do you know how much the 1 cent authority is for the NRDs?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I do not know. But I've been told that the city of Omaha would generate \$9 million at 5 cents.

SENATOR BOURNE: Five cents is only \$9 million?

SENATOR SCHROCK: That's what I've been told.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. And then it also give an additional 5 cent authority to cities and villages. Is that accurate?
