That whole sentence is dropped, so that all that is left is, "Only the Legislature may provide for the operation, regulation, and taxation of casino gaming at eight casino locations." The mild ambiguities there relate to the phrase "at eight casino locations," creating somewhat of an ambiguity between whether we can choose between one and eight, or we have to have exactly eight.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And leaving the word "Only the Legislature," does that mean that...is that intended to change the authority of the Legislature in any way? I assume we could still authorize a commission to regulate gaming under that language. Or is it restricted to the Legislature? I'm not sure. But the bottom line is, it doesn't improve anything, and it may hurt. It wouldn't be a bad amendment to consider further on Select File, if there is...can be shown to be some improvement. But I have yet to hear Senator Erdman argue what that exact improvement would be. So for the moment at least, I, for one, certainly would not...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...recommend this amendment to you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek and Senator Beutler. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Senator Erdman, I seem to see what you're trying to do here is to shorten the ballot question up a little, but the way it's written now, it is consistent with other language in the constitution. And that, I'm sure, is why Senator Schimek had this put in this way. And if you are successful here, I do believe that we need to have, after "gaming," "up to eight" at such casino locations. That definitely should be put in. But being consistent with the rest of the constitution, I...that is the way it is in several areas. And I believe that it...the way it is, it's not too long, it's short, it wouldn't take up a lot of space. You're shortening it up a little bit more. About the only thing it would do would be
