SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR TYSON: Because of the disposable income. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Tyson. Senator Erdman.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. To my good friend Senator Friend, if speaking two times and offering an amendment is a filibuster, then wow. For the record, if I may, a filibusterer is member of a legislature, especially the Senate, who obstructs the passage of a bill by making long speeches. I may have spoke two minutes on my opening. The use of this tactic is to obstruct a bill. So that's a filibusterer. So that's what I'm doing, evidently. I've offered an amendment to Senator Schimek to do what I think helps, and she agreed, or has some concerns in some other areas, and so there we have it. And so when we get into other filibusters this session, I'm assuming that the keeper of filibusterers, Senator "Nostradamus," will educate us on those as well. The amendment before you appears to me to be consistent with what we're doing, and that is we're doing something new. It is not consistent, as drafted under AM2401, with the existing language. And this is why. The existing language says there's nothing to restrict lottery, period. It's an open game. You can authorize a lottery. That's a full event, as many as you want throughout the state. Generally, it's governed by...and a specific activity governed directly by the Legislature. Here we're talking about specific number of entities. I think we have a little flexibility. However, if the members are opposed to FA1449, maybe they should just support LR 11CA, which, if I recall, only had 19 votes to advance from Select File, after a flawed attempt to adopt an amendment, which I had advised Senator Schimek against, which would have left the bill on Final Reading.
