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SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, because I think that's very, very vital. I will not be here next year but, hopefully, you people will take care of that. Because I think that's why this is a better proposal because we can come back after this constitutional amendment is passed and have enabling legislation that will help people that have this problem. And people can be cured from it. And so with that, I will give the rest of my time back to the Chair.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. President. I do have a question for Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Hartnett, would you respond to a question?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yes, I'll try to.

SENATOR SMITH: Now did you call it compulsory gambling?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Compulsory gambling, yeah, it's the Council for Compulsory (sic) Gamblers.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator...

SENATOR SMITH: Okay, I'm hoping that you mean...

SENATOR CUDABACK: ...Hartnett. I can't hear you, Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR SMITH: ...the Council on Compulsive Gambling. I realize that some in here might want compulsory gambling,...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Oh. (Laugh)

SENATOR SMITH: ...but I just want the...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay.
