SENATOR SCHIMEK: That is right.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Where are we going to get the money to promote this bill if we, in fact, decide to pass it? Because it would appear to me that it's going to take some strong support from somewhere.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I agree with you, Senator, and I don't...obviously, we don't have money to oppose or support any kind of a ballot issue. So I think a lot of it would have to be done by the people out there who prefer our point of view. And I'm sure that there will be some of those. I think that some of us will also have to continue talking about why we think our point of view is a better point of view.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you. In the final analysis, if I, in fact, do vote for this bill, I will spend as...the reason I brought up Senator Mines, I will spend the greatest share of my time trying to encourage the people that I represent to vote against any kind of gambling bill, because I don't believe gambling is the answer to any of our problems and, in fact, is the root of a lot of our trouble. For that reason, if I would decide to vote for this, my energy will be expended, because I'm not going to be here next year, but my energy would be expended in trying to convince the people in my district that any kind of...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR VRTISKA: ...gambling is bad. It's kind of interesting, they brought up Tim Hall's bill a few years ago that I didn't support, but we had some lengthy debate on that. And Senator Hall came over and asked me why I wouldn't support the bill. And I said, Senator, you let me put an amendment on and I'll support your bill. And he said, okay, I'll let you put it on; what is it? I said my amendment says that only rich people can gamble. Well, of course, he didn't want to buy that and neither would anybody else. But my point was the cost to the people who cannot afford it, and I think statistically we've seen that the most...the people who gamble the most are the people that can
