Judiciary Committee, you had a bill that also did something regarding regulation to tattooists, or body artists, or whatever they're called.

SENATOR STUHR: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: And if I recall, the committee did indefinitely postpone that bill. And you kind of tell me how this one is different than that?

SENATOR STUHR: Yes, Senator Bourne. Actually, what we have gone into in this bill is looking at the licensure and regulation of the practitioners and the facilities. What we were addressing when I brought the bill before Judiciary was only the consent of the parent or the guardian, having...and having that consent form signed. And so it dealt with that only particular...that one section. So this is much broader in scope.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay, so this is actually a licensure...

SENATOR STUHR: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...mechanism, as opposed to the parental consent...

SENATOR STUHR: Right.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...or that.

SENATOR STUHR: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: Now, let me ask you a question. In this committee amendment...and perhaps Senator Jensen is a better person to ask, but let's start with you. There is...in here it says that a tattoo artist has to have training. How...is there a facility or an entity where they get this type of training in order to perform body art?

SENATOR STUHR: Are you addressing that to me?
