state of Nebraska and he does so. He has some youngsters who want to take the ride with him. They're going to barrel down the interstate. They are under 18, each one of these young people. Senator Aguilar, without violating the law, cannot have any of those children sitting in the back of that pickup truck as he drives across the state of Nebraska. Now, if Senator Aguilar is going to move a load of newspapers across the state of Nebraska in the same vehicle, he can then put three young people below the age of 18 in the back of that pickup without them being secured, without the papers being secured, and drive them all the way across the state of Nebraska on the interstate and there is no liability on him for doing so. So it's clear we're going to eliminate some things. It is not the vehicle that we're concerned about. It's not the rate of speed of the vehicle we're concerned about. It's not anything related to the route taken by Senator Aguilar, the amount of time it takes him to get from one side of the state to the other, how many times he may or may not stop along the way. None of that means anything. So where is the focus? The focus is on the status, artificially created, of these children. If they are not working for Senator Aguilar, they cannot be put in that unsafe set of circumstances. If he creates an employer-employee relationship and they're working for him, and their job is to hold those papers, see, the work itself could be dangerous that they're asked to do. But if they are discharging an employee responsibility, they can be placed in that unsafe condition. Brothers and sisters, friends, enemies, neutrals, there is no place in the law of this state, and I had not heard of the law in any other state, which affirmatively says that children can be placed in unsafe conditions without liability, can be placed in circumstances which the law itself says are inherently unsafe. Why are you going to give one thing with your left hand and take it away with your right hand from certain children who are situated a certain way? I say that the similarity of situation of these children which ought to concern us is their age and the fact that they are...
