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working for...although Nebraska Furniture Mart I'm sure wouldn't do this, but they could be working for some company that delivers appliances and these children have to be back there to steady it. And they hire children because they can get them cheaper. The child is steadying a washer...you all know what a washer is, it washes clothes...and there is a refrigerator also in the truck. And the person takes a corner and the child is caught between the washer and the refrigerator because, being unsecured, it slides across the truck and pins the child between the washer and the refrigerator, and that's what you all want to say is legal and lawful. That is the dangerous condition these children can be made to work under and you all want to affirmatively say in the law...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...that the law will protect you from liability. That is one of the craziest things that I have seen come across this floor, but I expect crazy things to be brought to the Legislature. I expect the Legislature to vote for crazy things, and I expect some crazy things to be enacted into law over my strenuous opposition. Psychiatrists are medical doctors. They are supposed to try to heal the mind. A medical doctor can deal with a neurological condition. A psychiatrist can deal with a mental condition. Philosophers say that the mind and the body, the physical, the mental, the physical, the intellectual...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...combine to make one unit, and each part relies on and influences the other.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on FA1443, by Senator Chambers, to AM2236. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on amendment FA1443, offered by Senator Chambers to
