SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...how ever many I have.

CLERK: Senator, you only have one other one at this point.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I would like to withdraw that one.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, back to Senator Quandahl's amendment, AM2236.

SENATOR CUDABACK: And we're back to AM2236. Open for discussion. Seeing no discussion, Senator Quandahl, recognized to close, if you care to.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Yes, and as part of my closing I would ask for a call of the house so that all members could be present to vote on...or those that wish to be present can vote on this particular amendment. So I would ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Question before the body is, shall the house go under call? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.
