CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: The house is under call. All senators return to their desks. The house is under call. Senator Chambers, would you like to start closing?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I've said all that I need to say. I'll just mention, for the sake of everybody who's casting a vote, this is a vote to reconsider the vote that rejected Senator Schimek's amendment. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Senator Engel, Senator Jensen, Senator Johnson, Senator Schrock, Senator Landis, Senator Burling, Senator Quandahl, Senator Thompson, Senator Bourne. Senator Engel, would you check in, please. Senator Quandahl, Senator Schrock, Senator Thompson. Senator Thompson. Senator Schrock, Senator Quandahl. Senator Chambers, we do not know where Senator Quandahl is. You request for a machine vote? This is motion to reconsider. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, to reconsider the vote on Senator Schimek's amendment.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: The motion to reconsider passes. We will now proceed to Senator...Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a priority motion. Senator Schimek would ask unanimous consent to bracket the bill until February 11.

SENATOR WEHRBLIN: Is there any objections? Senator Chambers, question?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, that reconsideration vote means the amendment was adopted, right? It doesn't?
