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here before these penalties will kick in if they are not done on a timely manner. And so there still becomes no penalty on registration. It simply will be in addition to the taxes. At the current point, you pay the taxes, but there's no penalty. Now there will be an interest rate on the taxes, but the registration will...but there will still be no penalty. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Stuthman, on the Jones amendment.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I would like to ask a couple of questions of Senator Jones, if he'd respond, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jones, would you yield?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, I will.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Is this in relationship to older...say, like, trucks that we have, sometimes we don't license them until we use them in the fall for hauling silage and stuff like that. They were due in January and maybe we won't license them until August, just when we were getting ready to use them for cutting silage. The registration would be the same, but the taxes, there will be interest charged on the taxes from January, right?

SENATOR JONES: That's right, just on the taxes. Nothing to do with the registration, anything, because you've got to pay that retroactive back to January anyway. You never miss that.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: No, no, no. The bill...

SENATOR JONES: But this would be just charged on...

SENATOR STUTHMAN: ...will have...yeah. The amount of dollar owed will be from January. What are they doing at the present time? Like, my registration taxes are due in January; I do not license this beater truck until August. What is the current practice right now?
