SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jones. You've heard the closing on AM2417, offered by Senator Jones to AM2353. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on adoption of AM2417, offered by Senator Jones to the Wehrbein amendment to LB 279. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
