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of examinations and then pay the fee before my license can be reinstated?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Senator Chambers, I am not totally clear on this, but in my opinion, I think you would have to go through a lot of...if your license had been revoked for some reason or another, I feel that you would have to, you know, go through a process to get reinstated, not just pay the fine and then get the...get the permit. But I'm not totally clear on this.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Thank you. I'd like to ask Senator Jones a question.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Senator Jones.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Jones, will you take a shot at the same question?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, I would.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Jones, if a person's driver's license is revoked, what must that person do to have it reinstated, if you know?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, that happened in my district one time and he has to go back and take the driving test and examination, both, to get the license back again.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Thank you. So the analogy does not hold. But when your license is revoked, it usually is related to some safety...a violation of some safety provision. This is entirely different, in my opinion. I don't see Senator Stuhr. Oh, I see her approaching her mike, so rather than ask her a question and there not be enough time to respond to it on her part, I would like to hear her comments on this amendment and I assure Senator Stuhr that I will put my thinking cap on, that I will listen very attentively, and I will retain an open mind, but not an empty head. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Jensen, did you wish to speak to the amendment?
