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Bourne, both, have some good thoughts here, and if we can move the bill forward that would certainly be my desire. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Jensen. (Doctor of the day introduced.) Chair would recognize Senator Beutler. Do you wish to speak to the amendment?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I do not.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Chair recognizes Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I do agree with Senator Chambers' amendment. I'll be supporting that, but I think he didn't quite go far enough. Because then, if you read the next paragraph, it talks about, "Each body art facility license issued shall be in effect solely for the owner or owners and premises named thereon and shall lapse automatically upon any change of ownership or location." And it says, "An original application for licensure shall be submitted and approved before such facility may reopen for business." So my concern, and again, I think Senator Chambers is on the right track, but I think we probably should look at deleting that second paragraph as well. Because say, for example, Senator Synowiecki owned a tattoo shop and was licensed. I am also a licensed body artist and I want to buy his facility. I could not...he couldn't sell that to me automatically. I'd have to go back and reestablish, pay a new license fee. And you know what this kind of reminds me of is years ago we used to have a limited number of licenses to purchase...or liquor licenses, and so you'd have a bar that was kind of a dive and, yet, the license itself would be worth more than the bar, because they were difficult to get. And so I don't see why we would have to have, if a licensed body artist wanted to buy an already ongoing licensed body artist's business, I don't see why we'd have to lapse the license and then start over. So I think that we should look at that paragraph as well. And again, I want to make clear that I support the bill. I support what Senator Stuhr is trying to do and what the Health Committee is proposing. I just think that it goes a little bit too far. And as I mentioned on Thursday, I
