SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments are adopted. Anything further on the bill, Madam Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of LB 969. Senator Schrock, there are no lights on. You may close on the advancement to E & R Initial.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, Mr. President, members of the body, sometimes you're better off not to say anything and hope something passes. I did neglect to say that this bill is important to the Grand Island area and that's why Senator Aguilar prioritized the bill. It is Senator Aguilar's priority bill. He was in Grand Island this morning to make an announcement; regrets he can't be here. With that, I would ask for your support on LB 969. If there's any questions between now and Select File, we'd be glad to try and answer them. Certainly there are representatives available from OPPD, NPPD, and the municipalities involved that you could talk to between now and then also.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. You've heard the closing on the advancement of LB 969. The question before the body is advancement of LB 969 to E & R Initial.
