SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Mr. President, members. To kind of get back to the debate on Senator Schimek's amendment to Senator Louden's bill, again, what I see is that Senator Schimek is trying to provide a certain amount of unemployment compensation to people returning from military service in an international conflict, or from a national emergency. And while I appreciate what she's trying to do, I don't believe that unemployment insurance should flow to people who are already receiving compensation from some other government entity. So I don't think I'm going to support her amendment. And maybe I misstated, and she can clarify when she next speaks. But I don't think I'm going to support her amendment to Senator Louden's amendment, and I don't think I'm going to support Senator Louden's. Because again, I think if an individual is receiving Social Security retirement benefits, I'm not sure they should be entitled to receive unemployment, because that, to me, at least my feeling of what unemployment is, that's beyond the scope of it. Unemployment should be reserved to those people who absolutely need it to keep them, you know, in a home, to keep them from losing their car, to keep them off the Medicaid rolls. And again, I think what I see here is that Senator Cunningham is going to drive a certain number of people onto the Medicaid rolls, onto food stamps, because of his bill. And I was going to ask if he would yield to a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Cunningham, would you yield to a question from Senator Bourne?

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Yes, I would.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Senator Cunningham. We talked about this the other day, exactly what good cause is. And it was at the very end of the morning yesterday, and you said it was established by case law. Then I had another individual ask me this morning who...exactly what good cause is. And could you again tell us exactly...you know, I realize it's a general term,
