SENATOR CHAMBERS: And we've had several issues that came before us this session which were rejected primarily because of the fact that they had no public hearing. Is that right also?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, that happens every once in awhile. Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you remember me trying to make these freeloading, sponging, religious organizations pay sales and use taxes like everybody else, and a number of senators said that issue had no public hearing?

SENATOR JONES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You remember that?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, I did.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And do you remember that I agreed with the truth of what they said and I did not want to harm Senator Byars' bill, so I withdrew my amendment without even taking a vote on it? Do you remember that?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, I think I recollect that, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Now are you willing to remove that amendment that was adopted that would put the penalty on the late registration which was adopted the other day? Are you willing to remove that amendment?

SENATOR JONES: Well, what was adopted the other day was just the interest on the tax, nothing to do with the registration.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But the tax would come because a person was late in registering.

SENATOR JONES: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And the tax that would have been paid at the time of registration was not paid. So when the person comes to register, then the interest is paid on the tax that would have
