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SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you have almost five minutes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Thank you, Mr. President. I would like to ask Senator Jones a question, if he is on the floor.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jones, are you available for a question?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, I will...I will speak...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jones.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and then if he shows up then I will see him as he approaches his mike and then I'll put the...oh, here he comes now, so we'll observe a moment of silence while he approaches.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jones, would you yield?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, I would.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Jones, my motion is to return this bill to the Transportation Committee for a hearing.

SENATOR JONES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would you support my motion?

SENATOR JONES: No, I wouldn't.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The alternative to maybe getting us out of an impasse would be to remove the amendment that Senator Wehrbein persuaded us to attach and, by doing, restore the bill to its original state. Are you willing to pursue a course such as that?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, I would.
