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SENATOR JONES: Yes, we're working on it right now. We're letting the Bill Drafters take a look at it so we don't mess up, and we want to just remove the one that I got passed,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR JONES: ...one that Roger Wehrbein got passed, and then he'll withdraw the one we're talking about, so it gets it clear back down to the original bill.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right. Then in order that we will be able to let that work be done, I'm going to have to continue the discussion, I believe, and since I started it, I will be able to do it. So I'm going to take a vote on my motion, and I don't mind if people vote no, because we don't have to try to recommit it. Then I will offer a reconsideration motion, so that the debate can continue until that amendment is brought before us, but I won't have to fabricate an amendment to the bill that is...would be a sham amendment in the first place. So the reason I'm going to go ahead and take a vote is that a little more time will be consumed and the work can be done on the amendment. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: That was not a close, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh.

SENATOR CUDABACK: That was not a close.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jones is now recognized to speak, followed by Senator Wehrbein and...

SENATOR JONES: Mr. President and members of the body, we are working on an amendment, like I told Senator Chambers, and we're trying to get it put together so we do it right so that it would remove the tax and the penalties that we're talking about on the registration and the interest on the tax that's past due. We're trying to take that all out of it because we did not have that discussion in our committee, and if we can get that back to
