Because if you look at the charts that I passed out, it does have a significant impact. Counties alone could lose up to \$500,000 across the state. So that's the reason and I think that we could work through this, and that's all I have to say at this point.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Chambers, but you have spoken three times. Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Mr. President and members of the body, I think we do have things worked out now. I filed an amendment up there and so I guess I just got to decide when Roger Wehrbein and Senator Chambers would be willing to pull theirs. And I...can I give the rest of my time to Senator Chambers and let him talk about that a minute?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I withdraw my motion.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. We're back to the Wehrbein amendment. Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Are we ready? I will withdraw AM2515.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Wehrbein, AM2509.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. President, I would withdraw that.
