amended it to six years. We did that because that's the rotation on the lease they have on the equipment with Corrections out there. Their lease with their provider for the equipment is a six-year lease. Then I had an amendment adopted to change the fee from \$2.50, I believe it was, to \$3 per plate that was adopted. And that's the status of the bill now. If we adopt Senator Jones' amendment, that's where it exists as of, like I said, adopted my amendment and the committee amendment. It's as clean as we're going to make it. It's a six-year license plate bill. I would support Senator Jones' amendment to get it back to that stage and I think that I...I'm sure that I will make the commitment that we'll offer a bill. Someone will make sure there will be a bill offered next session addressing either penalties or taxes or some...or interest, I'm sorry, interest or penalties for late registration to take care of the issue of lost revenue at that time. So I certainly urge the body to support Senator Jones' amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. Further discussion on FA1459? Seeing none, Senator Jones, did you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR JONES: Mr. President and members of the body, I think you pretty well understand what's happening here now and so I appreciate your vote on this and we can get to moving on. Thank you.
