SENATOR THOMPSON: Well, the questions that are...let me find the page here with...

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...exactly what they'll be asked.

SENATOR BOURNE: I just...

SENATOR THOMPSON: They will be asked, do you wish to receive any additional specific information? First they're asked if they wish to be an organ...

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...and tissue donor. Then they're asked, do you wish to receive any additional specific information regarding organ and tissue donation and the Donor Registry of Nebraska?

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. So they won't necessarily be told that this information will be fed into a national database, although that could be part of what your committee would recommend as well, wouldn't it?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes. Well, at the time that they sign up they will be told about the Donor Registry.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. And so...but again, if...the way it is now, if I sign up for the Donor Registry, it just just appears on my driver's license, and I assume if I'm injured in a traffic accident the public safety personnel would just look at my
