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individual will have to prove his nationality by presenting the following documents: original birth certificate, and official photo ID. Please note that under international laws, a foreign government consular representation is entitled to issue these documents to its nationals. And the particular card is not just a cheap card. I mean, it's digitally approved, just like a driver's license in this country. It is a good form of ID, and the people ask for this for...not only to be able to utilize our banking system, not only to be able to...you know, it's an authorized form of ID. But one of the main reasons they get that is that if something ever happened to them while they were in this country they want some way to make sure that they get shipped...you know, if they were to lose their life, for instance, that their body would be shipped back home to their family. And the only way you can do that is with a true identification. This is a true identification. It is recognized in some other states. Nebraska chooses not to recognize it. And one of my goals is hopefully is to get that approved as a primary form of identification in this country. And again, I do support Senator Synowiecki's amendment. I know there's other amendments coming along. Senator Kruse has one. I think it's just as appropriate, and hopefully I'll support that one as well. And for now, I want to listen to the discussion. So thank you very much.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Aguilar. Senator Baker, on the Synowiecki amendment, followed by Senator Kruse, Senator Bourne, and Senator Mossey. Senator Baker. Senator Baker, did you wish to be recognized? Thank you.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. I don't...the amendment I just filed I hope...hopefully, replaces and addresses the concerns of Senator Synowiecki, Senator Bourne, Senator Aguilar, and it's not on the screen yet, but I think everyone has agreed to it. It takes out that trump exception there on page 6, line 8, and it says, except as provided by subsection 6 (sic--(d)). I will talk about it when it comes up. But I encourage people to go ahead and listen to the discussion here this morning, and as soon as that amendment comes up on the screen you can take a look at it. It's, I think, agreeable to everyone that had concerns about what this
