SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Further discussion on AM2609, offered by Senator Baker to LB 559? Anybody wishing to speak...address this amendment? Senator Baker, there are no lights on. You're recognized to close on AM2609.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. And I'll be very brief. I have a copy of it here now. It added...rather than referring to the act, it simply spells out, in the new amendment here, AM2609, Motor Vehicle Operator's License Act, and refers to a subsection (b) on page 6, line 8, and Section...or page 27, line 25. That's the only change. It does everything the other amendment did. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. You've heard the closing on AM2609. The question before the body is whether that amendment should be adopted.
