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SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and don't know how to address them. But I've put forth that effort, and I've been doing it for years. But when people show a lack of concern for children, they get on the wrong side of me. Even Jesus thought more of the children. He said it's better for you if a millstone was hung around your neck and you were drowned in the sea than that you should offend against one of these little children. And some people transpose words. Jesus said, bring the children to me; suffer the little children to come unto me. They turn it around and say, make the little children suffer. They just got it wrong, and I got to try to help righten their thinking. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Aguilar.

SENATOR AGUILAR: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I don't think anybody can say it any better than Senator Chambers; that he just did an excellent job of telling reality, what's really happening, what's really going on here. And I'm amazed at how hard the lobby is working right now to protect their interests. And how do they explain to these senators that children's lives do not matter? I'd love to hear their words. I'd love to hear that explanation out there in the lobby right now. I want to address a couple issues, one that Senator Quandahl brought up. He talked about making this law a criminal offense that would be penalized. That's right, Senator Quandahl. I honestly truly believe that if you're going to risk children's lives you are a criminal. That's what I believe. Another issue you brought up, you said that \$50 fine goes away, and you were concerned with that. You know what? You're right about that too, because under the seat belt law it goes to \$25. So there is protection there. Senator Erdman brought up a point that, you know, if you're...if you're driving down the interstate or whatever, you know, we have laws to protect against reckless driving. I made the point very early on in the discussion that it doesn't matter if you're going 25 miles an hour, it doesn't matter if you're stopped, it doesn't matter that you're not driving recklessly; it's what that other vehicle is doing. Please try to understand that, folks. This is about saving lives, and all your explanations in the world are really falling on deaf ears in
