SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Aguilar. Mr. President and members of the Legislature, who will speak for the children? I don't mean the unborn, because we know what would be happening if that's what this issue was. I even know where Senator Kremer would be if we were talking about unborn children. I know that Senator Foley would have been on his feet if we were talking about unborn children. I know that Bishop Bruskewitz would be giving orders. We'd have the Catholic Conference out there. We'd have "Schlecklegruber," whatever his name, out there giving orders. We'd have Julie Schmit-Albin out there if we were talking about unborn children. But when we talk about those children in being, in esse, as they say in philosophy, all those people who do all that yammering about their concern for the unborn are gone. That's why I always say, as soon as that fetus passes through the birth canal and comes into the world, those fetus lovers, those embryo lovers, those zygote lovers are no longer present because they don't love children. That's why Jesus say, you call me Lord, Lord, and you don't do what I tell you to do. How you going to say you love God, whom you haven't seen, and hate your brother, whom you have seen? How you going to say you love these unborn children and you hate these children who are in existence? That's what I see as crass hypocrisy and immorality. That is an example of where your words will justify you and your words will condemn you. If there was some way I could tie this into the unborn child issue, then I could get something done. What I may have to do is craft an amendment which says any child below the age of 18 years old who is riding in the bed of one of these pickups, and use the other descriptive language in this bill, and is not belted in is hereby proclaimed to be an unborn child.
