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take? If we get modern vehicles and use modern practices and look at things in a modern sort of way, we can have just as happy a situation. We can do the same work and we can be more protective, and I think that Senator Aguilar's suggestion, as he originally made it to this Legislature, was conceptually a very fine thing...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...and we should carry through with it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Stuhr, followed by Senator Aguilar. Senator Stuhr, on the Beutler amendment.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. I'm standing in support of the amendment and also the bill. I'm doing this because I really feel that the intent...Senator Aguilar brought us this bill with the intent to protect children, and I believe that that is still there. I'm glad that Senator Beutler did make some comments in relationship to detasseling, and just for the record I'd like to ask him another question, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, would you respond?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes, I will.

SENATOR STUHR: I was glad that you mentioned those items of husbandry because the question has been posed to me of transporting children in a field and do you think that this would apply to that particular area?
