the city of Lincoln, now the Lincoln ballpark complex, former landfill area in Sidney, a combine manufacturing plant in Grand Island, the Omaha riverfront redevelopment which includes a former recycling center, fire training facility and a portion of the pipeline property, a former salvage yard in Lincoln, KN Energy pipe storage yard in Holdrege, a grain elevator in Hastings, a petroleum products warehouse in Omaha. Basically, if we do not pass this law, we may not be able to access federal grant money. And in the case the grant money is granted, DEQ will grant a hearing if the public interest indicates that it is warranted.
