Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Uh-huh.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers and Senator Schimek. Senator Hartnett, on the Stuthman amendment, did you wish to...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Senator Stuthman, could I ask you a question or so?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuthman.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Yes.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Is the...are the treasurers in this state bonded? For, you know, they collect money and so...or they have a bond that they...

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Yes, I am sure.

SENATOR HARTNETT: And I guess then my question would be, because in your amendment here, election commissioner is going to collect some money from a candidate and so forth, are they bonded? Or maybe they don't need to be. Maybe we're talking about such a small amount of money. I just...when you were having the discussion with Senator Chambers and with Senator Schimek, I just, you know, just a thought occurred to me.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Senator Hartnett, the only thing that I could refer to is that I am almost sure that when I was elected as a county supervisor, that as a county supervisor we had to have a bond.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: So if we, as members of a county board of supervisors, would have to have a bond, I don't see any reason why the election commissioner or any other public officer
