SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. You've heard the opening on the committee amendments. Open for discussion on those amendments to LB 963, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I don't see the Speaker, but we're going to have a hearing at the Exec Board at noon, I believe, and I think we ought to think about getting out of here. But since I...it is my tradition to oppose adjournment, if you all want to stay here, then I will stay here with you, but I don't think this bill should have even started, but that's just my humble opinion. And being the humble person I am, I just thought I'd humbly make that statement.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any further discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Schimek, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President. I just explained. There don't seem to be any questions. I think I'm going to just pass over any more remarks.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question before the body is adoption of the committee amendments offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. All in favor of the committee amendments vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on adoption of the Military, Government (sic) and Veterans Affairs Committee amendments offered by Senator Schimek. Record please, Mr. Clerk. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, items if I may.
