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pretty precise.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do we have legal people around here?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, we do.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Are pieces of legislation sometimes crafted by these legal people?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Have you heard the dealings out...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I thought there was more to the sentence than that, but, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Have you heard what I've...and seen what I've had to do...

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...in terms of correcting and rectifying some of that that has come to us?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Well, now that you mention it, Senator, I would like to say that I think this bill was drafted very well.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm not talking about this particular amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: (Laugh) Okay. Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But you...that's why I said in the past you've seen me have to deal with legislation crafted by people with legal training.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. So not everybody is competent just because he or she has a title. Would you agree?
