January 1, 2004, are adopted as Nebraska law and are applicable to all persons in military service as defined in Public Law 108-189, Title I, Section 101. The Legislature hereby adopts the following sections." Then it lists out various sections specifically. Senator, these sections listed specifically are outside of those found in 108 through 189. Is that true?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Or does not 108 through 189 refer to specific sections?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I...well, I believe...no, I...say your question again, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It seems to me what this language in Section 2, found in the green copy, is saying is that all of the sections and any sections mentioned by such sections are adopted as Nebraska law.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: And it refers to particular parts of that, I believe, Senator,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Title I...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...which is Section 108 and 109, and I'm looking for it here because I do have a copy of this...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...public law, and I just found 108 and I have found 109.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But here's why that difficult for me. That's what I thought, but when we get into line 9 we say, "as defined in Public Law 108-189, Title I, Section 101." So does
