People get upset when bills like this are discussed, but they don't know what it means, but I'm not going to put a vote on it when I don't know what it means. And I don't know what these federal provisions are...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...that are written and applied to one category of persons and it's being adopted bodily in Nebraska and applied to another class, not the ones envisioned by the federal law. That's why you have to say all of that applies to members of the Nebraska National Guard, and when you begin to look at the actual language of the bill, the green copy, there's a whole lot going on here that people have no idea about. And I was going to take it methodically. And even though Senator Beutler is jumping the gun, his doing so raises the red flags.
