SENATOR CHAMBERS: There is an assistant adjutant general of the reserves, but we're not talking about the Army Reserves in this bill. Would you agree with that?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I would agree with that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So the Adjutant...the assistant adjutant we're talking about is the one that would be connected with the National Guard. That is the one we're discussing.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, the assistant adjutant...or not the assistant, the deputy adjutant.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, this person was an assistant of the guard, I thought, the one in the article that I handed around.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The one in the article that you handed around says the assistant adjutant general joined the Air Guard, and then in, yes, in '79 he joined the Nebraska Air Guard. And, of course, they are both affiliated with the National Guard.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right, so we're talking about an assistant adjutant general connected with the National Guard. Would you agree?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: That's right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Schimek, if there is nothing in the statute that authorizes the position of assistant adjutant, by what authority would the adjutant general appoint such a person to that nonexistent position?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: To the nonexistent position of assistant?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Assistant adjutant general.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I'm not sure that he is the one that appoints. I just said I don't know how they get that position. Probably that's how, but...
