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knowingly do something but not intend to accomplish that which makes it a crime. It's difficult to explain the difference between knowingly and intentionally. Now I may knowingly commit an act but my intent is not to bring about the result that is illegal. But at any rate, take my word for it, this combination of words "knowingly and intentionally" accompany the description of what constitutes a crime in Nebraska. If these amendments are adopted, my amendment to Senator Beutler's, then his amendment to the bill, that will not mean that I would agree that we should retain these criminal sanctions. It just means that if they are going to be a part of the law, they should be drafted in conformance with the way such things are found in Nebraska law at this time. If you have any questions of me, I'm prepared to answer them.
