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same kind of...well, I don't know. To me it's not as difficult except that I understand you're saying we haven't dealt with each one of these issues that is involved and that we're adopting. Now if we believe that all this is so bad that we don't want to...that we want to take the time to go over each one of these and scrutinize them, analyze them, determine what they say and how they...that's okay, but I guess I fail to understand the reason why because it's already in the federal law. And are we that different than the...from the federals? If these people are serving in an activity as state troopers...as state National Guardspeople and they are actually performing national duties, so what's the big...what's the difference? And I guess you can explain that to me if you can. I'm at a loss. And I agree with you that this is too early in the morning to take up this deep a detail, but I thought we could get it done without going through this exercise. But anyway, I will turn the rest of my time over to Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, about two and a half minutes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm going to quote Marvin Gaye: Makes me want to holler and throw up both my hands. Makes me want to holler and throw up both my hands. Let me try again. And I don't think Senator Vrtiska is alone. Senator Vrtiska, you're willing to stand on your feet and speak. Here is what we're being asked to adopt: any other portions of federal law referred to in the federal Servicemembers Civil Relief Act in existence and effective as of January 1, 2004. If that Relief Act refers to 30 other titles of federal statute, just refers to them, we're adopting those titles so referred to in Nebraska law. If it refers to 100 sections in other portions scattered throughout the federal statutes, the mere reference to those statutes in this Relief Act are adopted into Nebraska law.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm going to read the language of this amendment and you can see if I'm misstating: The portions of the
