SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Schimek, on the Vrtiska amendment. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I stand for two reasons, and one is to try to explain the wording at the beginning of Section 2 one more time, and so that we can all understand it. And I will do the best I can to make it clearer. Senator Chambers, here's the way I think it reads. As you look at line 5, it says, the sections of the federal Servicemembers Civil Relief Act, Public Law 108-189, listed in this section, meaning down here on the rest of the bill, and then it says, or any other sections referenced by such sections. In other words, if there are sections within the sections we've referenced in this bill, then they...that are already in federal law in existence and effective, then they will apply. For instance, there is in 10...Section 105, there is a reference to the term "motor vehicle" and that has meaning given that term in Section 30102(a)(6) of Title 49 U.S. Code. I mean, there are a lot of things that are already in federal law that if they are referenced in this particular section, 101 or 105 or whatever, then they're automatically in. Okay, so you do read it that way, and...but you disagree with the way that...and, Senator Chambers, would you care to...
