SENATOR CUDABACK: Did you say Senator Jensen or Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JONES: Janssen.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Janssen, would you respond?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Certainly.

SENATOR JONES: Senator Janssen, I just wanted to ask you a couple of questions. Let's, for example, say there is four petition drive casinos get on the ballot and this one gets on.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Um-hum.

SENATOR JONES: Each one stands individual. They either got to have 51 percent to pass.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Um-hum.

SENATOR JONES: If all four of them or all five of them pass, whatever many this is, including ours, we got all that in our constitution, where do you go from there?

SENATOR JANSSEN: On areas that they conflict, Senator Jones, the one with the most votes goes on.

SENATOR JONES: Well, one could have 60 percent and the rest of them all have 51, and the only one with 60 percent would go forward.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Where they conflict, the areas that they conflict, then the one with the highest percentage goes on the ballot, the one with the most votes will be enacted. It will be enacted. Excuse me, they already have been on the ballot, so...
