General Funds? No. But it helps the General Fund budget because they don't have to bond, they don't have to have ongoing expenses, et cetera. I...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...really believe that it should never go into the General Fund. Concerning your amendment, I guess...I've got my light on and I would like to talk about it a little bit. It's something that I've been looking at since General File, and more questions have come up about it than could be answered. And the first question that I would have about the way your amendment is written is the word "location." You know if we could...there ought to be another way of phrasing that if we're really going to do this, casino gaming or casino or whatever. But when you start talking location, you start talking land, and you start talking speculation as to where it's going to be, and you start getting those extracurricular kinds of activities going. And I'm not sure that you want that. I think what you want to do, overall, if I'm getting the sense of your amendment, is to say whether you want casino gaming in that county or city. And I'd give you time but I think I'm...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...out, Senator Smith. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek and Senator Janssen. (Visitors introduced.) Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. President and members. And, Senator Schimek, I guess I'll refer to the location, I mean if you notice that it refers back to the locations, plural, that you have in your own amendment. So I'm not sure what the concern is there because of...I mean, yes, it might be vague but it's constitutional and certainly the Legislature, as you've indicated before, could be more specific in trailer legislation. So I'm not sure how well grounded your concerns are. I know it's your desire to legislatively visit the issue. I respectfully disagree; that if the voters have the prerogative to vote up or down whether casino gambling should be allowed in
