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SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, your time is up,...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...I think that probably the Legislature...

SENATOR CUDABACK: ...but, Senator Schimek, you're recognized.  
Are you...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Oh. Senator, Senator Smith, we can continue  
because we're on my time now. So I'm just guessing now, but  
that would be my best guess.

SENATOR SMITH: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes. First of all, I have to say that when I  
spoke about this amendment yesterday, I was speaking about my  
amendment and actually that one hasn't been filed yet. It's a  
different amendment that has been filed. So the location  
question wasn't really addressed in the amendment I was talking  
about. And, Senator Smith, I mentioned that to you off the  
mike, but I wanted to say that for the body. I'm going to  
oppose this amendment, not because I oppose what Senator Smith  
is trying to do, but I've got questions about it. I don't think  
the wording is right, and if this body indicates that it would  
really like to do something in this arena, I think we could come  
back with some language on Monday. But I'm not sure we need to  
do this in the constitution. Again, I think it could be done in  
enabling language. But, Senator Smith, here are the problems  
that I have with this. First of all, I think it could be done  
in enabling language, but if this body wants to do it in the  
constitution, I don't have an objection to that. It's okay.  
Secondly, it mentions that it's subject to the approval of the  
voters in the county voting, and I'm not sure that it should say  
county. It could be just the city that needs to vote. And  
that's kind of the questions we were running into when we were  
trying to put language together. And then, finally, it says on  
the question of whether such casino location shall be in such  
county, and again, as I mentioned yesterday, I don't think you  
want to put the word "location" in there, because that leads  
to...or could possibly lead to land speculation, and I don't  
think we want to do that. The other thing that's really not
